Show Hall: Sanford Civic Center, 401 Seminole Blvd., Sanford, FL 32771. Parking is free. Food available for purchase. No outside food is to be brought in unless specific approval is granted by show management. Show hall is non-smoking, climate controlled, alcohol free, wheelchair accessible facility.

ALCOHOL POLICY: For liability reasons this show has a no open container policy. Any exhibitors found to have open alcohol containers, alcoholic beverages, or non-liquid equivalents such as "Jello shots", in the showhall will be asked to remove them from the showhall. Sealed containers are allowed as long as they remain sealed within the confines of the showhall.

Show catalogs: Unless you request and pay for a printed catalog (\$10) you will receive your show catalog on Wednesday before the show by email as a PDF file. When you submit your summary sheet you need to indicate if you want a printed show catalog or if you are fine with the electronic version. The electronic catalog will be sent to the email address you have registered in TOES.

**Entry & Payment Information:** All entries must be paid prior to the expiration date of those fees otherwise you will be responsible for the rates at time of payment. Make checks payable to MysTICAI Moon Cat Club and mail to Vanadis Crawford, 209 Hillstone Drive, Raleigh, NC 27615-4911. PayPal payments can be sent to MysticalmoonCC@yahoo.com. All payments at check-in must be EXACT CASH only. No substitutions after closing. No refunds for failure to bench. Check your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with any corrections BEFORE CLOSING.

**Check in & Show Hours:** Saturday Check-in will be 7:30 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. Judging will start promptly at 9:00 a.m. Advertised show hours are until 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. Sunday doors open at 8:00 and there will be a regional meeting at 9:00 a.m. Judging begins at 9:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Show is open to the public; no cats may be removed from the show hall before the end of advertised show hours without permission of show management.

**Benching and Supplies:** Four (4) kittens, two (2) cats, or one (1) cat and two kittens (2) are permitted in a double cage. Additional double cages (22x22x45) are available upon request for an additional fee of \$45. A grooming space is the same size as a double cage space. Special benching requests will be honored to the best of our ability. For your cat's comfort, the top, sides, and bottom of the cages must be covered. Vending from the benching area, unless prearranged with the club, is prohibited. Litter will be provided, but please bring your own litter box.

**Grooming spaces**: These measure 44"L x 22"D and are on a wait list basis only depending on space availability. The earlier you enter, the greater the possibility that you will be on the top of the list for a grooming space. If we can give you a grooming space, you can pay for it at check-in at the show.

Services: Litter will be available. Please bring your own litter pans, cat food and bowls.

**Registration:** To show a cat in a TICA show your cat must be able to be registered in TICA. If not already TICA registered, pedigree cats must provide proof of registerability in order to enter. This can include paperwork from another recognized registry, pedigree, or similar information. Contact the entry clerk for more information and assistance. Household Pets and Household Pet Kittens do not need to be TICA registered to compete. However, to be scored for TICA titles and Regional/International awards, all cats

(other than household pet kittens) must be registered by their second show. Please contact TICA for registration information (TICA, P. O. Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551) or at www.tica.org

**Kittens:** Kittens entered in the show must be at least 4 months, but less than 8 months of age on the day of the show. Altered kittens are eligible for entry.

**Household Pets:** Household pets are very welcome at this show! Household pets 8 months of age or older MUST be spayed or neutered. If you are not sure of the proper class or color, send the entry clerk a color photo of your entry. Photos will be returned at check-in.

**Health:** It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. Florida has specific statutes related to the sale of cats and kittens. MysTICAI Moon expects all who plan on selling cats and kittens at the show to adhere to those statutes. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. Any cat or kitten from a house or cattery where there has been fungus or any infectious or contagious illness within 21 days prior to the opening date of the show is ineligible for entry and/or exhibition. Any cat which is obviously pregnant, or lactating will be disqualified. All claws (front and back) must be clipped prior to judging. This is a non-vetted show.

**Cats for Sale:** Kittens must be three (3) calendar months of age. Proof of age must be provided on request. Florida requires health certificates for all for sale cats or kittens. No kittens or cats may be confined to carriers during show hours. Any person disregarding these rules will be asked to leave the showhall. TICA rules allow no more than two kittens or one cat 8 months of age or older benched in a single ½ cage space. Sales cages will only be available for individuals with entries in the show.

**Show Rules:** TICA Show Rules will be strictly enforced. By entering all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the Judges and Show Committee. **Liability:** No watchman will be provided during non-show hours. Cats cannot be left in the show hall overnight. MysTICAI Moon Cat Club will take reasonable care to safeguard the personal property of exhibitors; however, neither the club, its members nor the show hall or hotels will be liable for any loss, damage or injury to exhibitors or to their cats.

**Clerks/Stewards:** If you are interested in Clerking, please indicate so on the summary sheet, along with any judge preference. TICA licensed clerks will be given preference and judge requests will be honored to the best of our ability. TICA clerks will be compensated \$30 per session plus lunch and a fully marked catalogue. Our stewarding needs will be met by The Young men of Excellence so we will not be needing anyone for this show.

**Awards:** Awards will be awarded in accordance with TICA Show Rules. This show is scored for TICA Regional and International awards.

**Sponsors**: A show cannot survive without sponsors our judges– you can sponsor one of our judges for \$25. Or, better yet, you can sponsor ALL judges in ALL rings for the entire show for \$100!

Clerking School: There will be a clerking school on Friday, November 11, starting at 5:30 p.m.at the TBD, taught by Vanadis Crawford, TICA Master Clerk and TICA Entry Clerking Administrator. Cost for the school is \$10. Please send an email to vanadis\_ec@nc.rr.com to sign up for the school. This will be an extensive school covering all you need to know to be a successful TICA clerk. Even if you don't want to clerk, you will learn a lot about how your TICA shows work. Since this school will be several hours in length, we will have menus for local restaurants and the club will pick up to-go orders for all students. (Meal costs to be paid by the student.)

There will be a genetics seminar for all exhibitors and judges alike, to be held by Lorraine Shelton, at a Saturday night Buffet. Specifics will follow shortly.
